The above Map is a representation of the town of Athens including that portion known as Cobham and the lands belonging to the College. The old part of the town is numbered from 1 to 67. The second survey by Major James Menanthen, from one to thirty one inclusive and the third addition surveyed by C. P. Thomas in 1833, is numbered from thirty two to twenty one inclusive, and the adjoining lots laid off in October 1844, are numbered from seventy two to ninety nine. Cobham is numbered from 72 to 109.
